# Classic Irish Whiskey

## **Bushmills Malt (10 Year Old)**

€7.00

*A product of the world's oldest licensed whiskey distillery, the "Old Bushmills" Distillery, Bushmills Single Malt Irish Whiskey is the original single malt whiskey from Ireland. With an intriguing aroma and well balanced flavour, Bushmills Malt is a delightfully delicate malt and uncomplicated whiskey crafted from 100% malted barley. Like Bushmills and Black Bush, it is 80 proof (40% alc./vol), but Bushmills Malt is a single malt whiskey. It ages for a minimum of 10 years in select bourbon oak casks and a select number of Oloroso sherry casks, developing its full flavour, character and hue. Triple distilled for exceptional smoothness, Bushmills Malt is 40% alcohol by volume.*

## **Bushmills Malt (16 Year Old)**

€8.50

*A premium, rare single Irish malt whiskey. Unique "Three Wood" finishing adds elements of depth and flavour to the already clean, non-smoky taste of Bushmills Irish Malt Whiskey. This exceptional malt whiskey is matured in three different wood barrels for unparalleled taste and quality. The whiskey is first matured in American bourbon barrels and Spanish Oloroso sherry butts for at least 16 years. While lingering in the bourbon barrels and sherry butts, the spirit develops toasted wood, vanilla and sweet nutty flavours. The malt whiskey is then vatted and married for many months in large old port wine pipes. Here a nice finishing touch of sweet wine character is acquired, and all of the flavour elements mature and mellow together. All of the malt used in our mash is dried in closed kilns devoid of peat. This prevents it from absorbing the fire's smokiness while retaining the malt's distinctive, authentic character and exceptionally clean taste.*

## **Midleton (Very Rare)**

*A fine scented, spicy bouquet with floral and herbal touches. The taste sensation is unique, with almonds, dried fruits, honey and floral nuances all evident. The lingering finish has a touch of toasted oak wood in the background. A drop of water may be added according to taste.*

## **Redbreast**



*In keeping with the tradition of pot still whiskey, Redbreast is strongly flavoured and assertive. On the nose and palate, a complex blend of spicy, oily sherry and toasted wood vanilla notes is evident. An Irish to be savoured, Redbreast is a treat for the connoisseur of fine old whiskey.*

## **Powers Special Reserve Whiskey (12 Year Old)**

*This triple distilled whiskey has all the typical characteristics of Powers - spicy honeyed, a touch of perfumed oils, full bodied and flavoursome. This familiar taste has been enhanced and enriched by the long years of extra ageing in oak. A velvet smooth finish with a touch of gentle woodiness.*

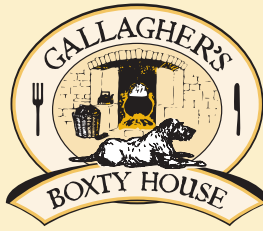
