A TREAT OF SIMPLICITY

While ice cream sandwiches originated in the United States in the late 19th century, Ireland quickly adopted its own versions. The most iconic producer was Hazelbrook Farm Ice Cream, whose branded freezer boxes and chest freezers became fixtures in local shops across the country.

Unlike the towering 99 cone with its flake, the ice cream sandwich felt understated. It didn't drip dramatically. It didn't demand urgency. It slowly softened at the edges, leaving faint chocolate smudges on your fingers.

And in the Irish climate — where summer heat is generous but rarely extreme — it was perfectly suited. Warm enough to melt slightly. Cool enough that it didn't disappear instantly.

It was more than just ice cream for many Irish people, the memory isn't just about taste. It's really about long evenings when the sun didn't set until nearly 10pm, playing football on the green until called in, the smell of freshly cut grass, sitting on a low garden wall sharing jokes and the rare, glorious stretch of good weather.

The ice cream sandwich became part of that sensory memory — a small square of independence. You didn't need a spoon. You didn't need a plate. Just a couple of shquids and the freedom of the estate.
